Bud Light – Light Lager – 4.2%

Taste is fresh and snappy, light in color, with a light body. Introduced nationally in 1982, Bud Light is brewed with a malt and hop ratio different from Budweiser for a distinctively crisp taste with fewer calories. It became the country's No. 1 light beer in 1994.



Guinness Draught – Irish Stout – 4.2%

Guinness Draught is one of the top selling imported draught beers in America. A unique mix of nitrogen gas and carbon dioxide creates the swirling liquid that tumbles, surges and eventually separates into the black liquid and the characteristic smooth creamy head that sits atop the perfect pint. With an initial malt and caramel flavor, Guinness Draught finishes with a dry roasted bitterness.



Smithwicks – Irish Ale – 4.5%

Smithwicks has a ruby red tone with a stable, but slightly thin head. Its texture is smooth and finishes clean. Although of lesser fame than Guinness, Smithwicks is often regarded as the 'local favorite' amongst Irish pub goers.



Stella Artois – Lager – 5.2%

Only the very best barley and the finest hops are selected for Stella Artois. The care and attention at every step in the brewing process enable Stella Artois to mature into a full-bodied and exceptionally well-balanced beer, perfectly thirst quenching, and perfect for everyday special moments.



Hoegaarden – White Beer – 5.0%

Hoegaarden is the authentic Belgian wheat or white beer. It has a unique and extremely complex brewing process whereby the brand is first top fermented and then is refermented within the bottle - ending up in a unique cloudy-white appearance. The brand's unique appearance is mirrored by its one-of-a-kind taste - sweet and sour beer with a little bitterness, slightly spicy, with a strong touch of coriander and a hint of orange, perfect for warm summer days, instead of other refreshing beverages.



Spotted Cow – Ale – 5.1%

Cask conditioned ale has been the popular choice among brews since long before prohibition. We continue this pioneer spirit with our Wisconsin farmhouse ale. Brewed with flaked barley and the finest Wisconsin malts. We even give a nod to our farmers with a little hint of corn.



Haywire Hefeweizen – Hefeweizen – 5.2%

Brewed by the original Wheat Beer Pioneers, Pyramid Haywire Hefeweizen is left unfiltered for extra flavor and aroma. Handcrafted with 60% malted wheat (10% more than Bavarian tradition calls for), our award-winning Hefeweizen is unsurpassed in quality and exceptionally smooth and refreshing for the whole beer experience.



Rusty Red – Red Ale – 5.5%

A smooth malty Red Ale with hints of caramel and roast. Inspired by the beers of Vienna with a added twist of American style. "Rusty Red, this ones for you!"

- Hefeweizen** – Fruity and cloudy with a low hop profile
- Belgium White** - Refreshing and cloudy with low bitterness
- Stout** - Light-bodied, highly drinkable with a dry roasted creamy flavor
- English Bitter** – Light-bodied with a moderate to assertive hop bitterness
- Pale Ale** - A fruity copper-colored ale with a good balance of malt and hops
- Wisconsin Ale** – Light bodied, fruity and cloudy with hint of corn

- Pilsner** – A golden lager with a flowerful aroma and dry finish
- Doppelbock** – Very full bodied with intense malty flavor and high alcohol content
- American Lager** – Light-bodied with a low to medium bitterness, balanced maltiness and a moderate hop flavor
- American Light Lager** – Light-bodied and thirst quenching with only a trace of malt flavor
- European Lager** – Light bodied with moderate bitterness and a smooth taste
